



Environment Policy

Dorset Treeworx understand the importance of preserving the environment for both the local areas and throughout the world. Our policy is to minimise the environmental impact of our work in any way we can and for us to take every precaution possible to avoid damage to the habitat. Aiming to decrease/limit pollution and ensure that as much of our work is as environmentally friendly and sustainable as possible. We will update our policies and working practices, as and when, to continue to deliver the best possible care to the environment and ensure all staff are up to date with the changes implemented.

Tree Preservation

We work with local councils and customers to protect trees with tree preservation orders (TPO) or part of conservation areas. We offer to work with customers to help and advise with regards to the tree applications on protected trees. Offering do the tree applications (if required) for the customer free of charge or for reasonable charge to make sure the tree work asked for is balanced for the trees health as well as maintaining the tree within its location. We will offer a replanting service to all trees being felled due to poor health or to be felled due to other reasons.

We can if you wish leaving tree stumps and habitat brush piles help with the local fauna and encourage wildlife.

Just ask a staff member if you require a bird box installing in the tree we are working on.

Before we carry out any work we will check for animals and flora & fauna and if there is we will assess (as this could presence could restrict our work) and inform the customer.

Are wood and wood chip is either recycled through recognised disposal companies or donated to be used is firewood, garden mulch. The green waste is sent to ECO companies for recycling in order to minimise landfill.
